<u>The Confidence Man</u> is an exhibition that looks at small gestures, lost objects and independent patterns. The materials used seem unagitated. The punctuation is pragmatic, yet not easy to decipher. All works in <u>The</u> <u>Confidence-Man</u> testify a seemingly indifferent sovereignty towards art. As a result an approach is introduced, which is pleasantly simple. At American universities there is a large debate surrounding the potential of unlearning. To forget something once understood is increasingly seen as valuable. Parallel to that, there are artists now, who deliberately evade a complex derivation of their work. Work speaks for itself. It constitutes a separate perceptive space. Instead of seeing ones expectations validated, as an observer at times one looses overview.
